



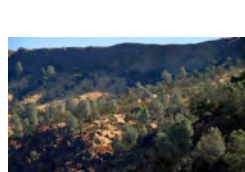

#### ***Jailhouse Rock Acquisition Campaign***

To secure permanent public access to and long-term conservation of Jailhouse Rock climbing area near Sonora, California.

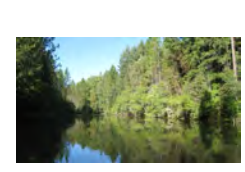
**Adirondack Mountain Club, *Lake George, NY*** **\$30,000**



#### ***Campaign to Protect our Public Lands from Drilling & Mining***

To secure the highest level of environmental and resource protection for Allegany State Park and New York State Forests through the purchase of sub-surface rights by the state; or through the passage of new legislation that prevents hydro-fracking mining from taking place within park boundaries.

**American River Conservancy, *Coloma, CA*** **30,000**



#### ***Bear Creek Acquisition***

To permanently preserve 442 acres of riparian, wetland and forest habitat, including 2.5 miles of riverfront, providing a necessary linkage between National Forest lands along California's American River.

**California Wilderness Coalition, *Oakland, CA*** **\$35,000**



#### ***California Wilderness Campaign***

To permanently protect more than 1,825,000 acres and 226 miles of streams in the California desert, San Diego County and the Los Padres National Forest.

**Canadian Parks and Wilderness Society, *Ottawa, ON*** **\$30,000**



#### ***Protecting the Great Slave Lake Campaign***

To permanently protect 7.4 million acres of land in the proposed Thaidene Nene National Park Reserve near the East Arm of Great Slave Lake in Canada's Northwest Territories.

**Conservation Resource Alliance, *Traverse City, MI*** **\$30,000**



#### ***Boardman River Dam Removal Campaign***

To remove four dams and restore 20 miles of the Boardman River in Michigan.

**Deschutes Land Trust, *Bend, OR*** **\$30,000**



#### ***Skyline Forest Campaign***

To acquire the 33,000-acre Skyline Community Forest and protect 250,000 acres of private forestland on the east flank of the Cascade Mountains.

**Dogwood Initiative, *Victoria, BC*** **\$30,000**



#### ***Coastal Oil Tanker Campaign***

To secure a legislated ban on oil tankers in coastal British Columbia, thereby stopping current and future proposed oil tanker projects, including the Enbridge Northern Gateway proposal, a gas pipeline and terminal project planned for BC's coastal Great Bear Rainforest.

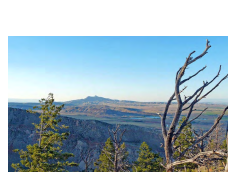
**Grand Canyon Wildlands Council, *Flagstaff, AZ*** **30,000**



#### ***North Kaibab National Monument***

To designate the North Kaibab/Theodore Roosevelt National Monument/Wildlife Conservation Area in Arizona.

**Greater Yellowstone Coalition, *Bozeman, MT*** **\$30,000**



#### ***Absaroka Beartooth Front Protection Program***

To secure protection for the 3.3-million-acre Absaroka Beartooth Front, including an energy withdrawal from critical wildlife habitat and migration corridors.

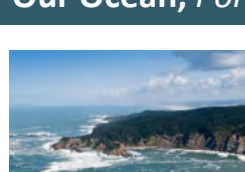
**New Mexico Wilderness Alliance, *Albuquerque, NM*** **\$30,000**



#### ***Otero Mesa National Monument Campaign***

To build statewide and local support to secure National Monument status for the 1-million-acre Otero Mesa in New Mexico.

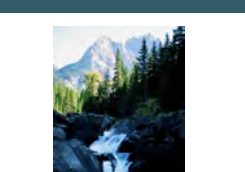
**Our Ocean, *Portland, OR*** **\$30,000**



#### ***Oregon Marine Heritage Campaign***

To designate and implement Oregon's first-ever, coast-wide network of at least six ecologically significant marine reserves and protected areas.

#### ***Campaign for Montana's Headwaters***

To protect and restore Montana's best remaining rivers and their watersheds for future generations of people and aquatic species.

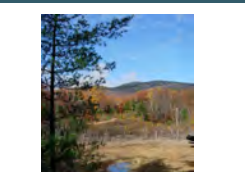
**Rivers Without Borders, *Clinton, WA*** **\$25,000**



#### ***Taku Watershed Conservation Campaign***

To secure a Critical Habitat designation for the Taku River watershed, keeping it wild and fully intact by preventing mining and associated development activities.

**Society for the Protection of New Hampshire Forests, *Concord, NH*** **\$25,000**



#### ***Mount Monadnock Royce Property Acquisition***

To permanently protect the 52-acre "hole in the donut" of conservation land on the flank of Mt. Monadnock, the most popular hiking destination in North America, for public access and recreational enjoyment.

**The Wilderness Society - ID, *Boise, ID*** **\$30,000**



#### ***Clearwater Basin Wilderness Campaign***

To protect a minimum of 500,000 acres in the Clearwater Basin through wilderness and other congressional designations, and to protect a minimum of 200 miles of river under the Wild & Scenic Rivers Act.

**Western Rivers Conservancy, *Portland, OR*** **\$30,000**



#### ***John Day River Project***

To permanently protect the riparian and shrub-steppe habitat on more than 19,000 acres, and provide unparalleled wild land recreational experiences along 18 miles of Oregon's John Day River, the longest free-flowing river west of the Continental Divide.
